



## HOW TO GROW THE BEST PETUNIAS

The key to success with petunias is sun. Petunias are sun loving plants that do their best when they get at least six hours of direct sun each day.



If you are willing to accept fewer flowers and a little more open growth habit, petunias will do alright with four hours direct sun.

Petunias are not especially demanding as to soil type or pH, but they do like to have well drained soil.

Petunias will bloom more readily if they are kept fertilized.

When transplanting petunia seedlings and potted colour there is no need to plant them

any deeper than they were originally growing.

Petunias may account problems with aphids or slugs, so be sure to check them often enough, especially in the seedling stage. Using snail or slug pellets around the plant should solve the problem or any other natural snail and slug deterrent.

During humid weather there may be problems with blooms getting black mould or spotting. Just pick those blooms off. As the weather dries that plants will be okay.
